This slide was remotely triggered and propagated over 200 meters wide. The slope is northeast facing around 9,000 ft. This event is a clear indication weak snow at the ground is struggling to support the new load. Shady, upper elevation slopes are the most likely to hold weak snow. Photo GNFAC
